Honourable Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign Affairs arrived in Lhasa, Tibet Autonomous Region of the People's Republic of China today.

The Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign Affairs held a bilateral meeting with H.E. Mr. Wang Junzheng, Secretary of the CPC Tibet Autonomous Regional Committee of the People's Republic of China in Lhasa. During the meeting, the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign Affairs expressed satisfaction over the excellent state of bilateral relations between Nepal and the People's Republic of China, particularly highlighting economic and cultural relations.

The Deputy Prime Minister reiterated the need of reopening of traditional border points for promoting trade and commerce as well as facilitating movement of peoples. He also underscored the importance of exporting products of Nepal including Haylage, cooked buffalo meat, medicinal herbs among others to further strengthen the economic cooperation.

The Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign Affairs further expressed the need to cooperate in the areas of infrastructure and connectivity including the transmission lines to further strengthen the bilateral ties.

Both sides exchanged views on effective implementation of the agreement and understandings reached between Nepal and the People's Republic of China.

The two leaders discussed matters relating to expanding socio-economic cooperation, enhancing understanding and goodwill through high level exchanges, consolidating the ongoing cooperation and exploring new areas of cooperation.

Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign Affairs also attended the banquet hosted by H.E. Wang Junzheng in his honour.

Earlier in the afternoon, the visiting Nepali delegation led by the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign Affairs visited the Consulate General of Nepal in Lhasa.

The members of the Nepali delegation as well as senior officials of the China's TAR were present in the meeting.
